The three parties will collaborate to promote and give advice to Thai entrepreneurs wishing to trade or invest in Cambodia. Cambodia is one of Thailand's major export markets. Key export items to Cambodia mainly are gems and jewelry, petroleum products, and beverages. Thailand-Cambodia trade value between January-November 2016 totaled 4,960.74 US million dollars while Thailand is the top 9th foreign investor of Cambodia with direct investment totaling 930.86 US million dollars.
